DRAWING - FOR YOUTH

OBSERVATIONAL DRAWING Ages 10-14

Instructor: Svetlana Shkuratova

Drawing is a great way of researching, developing, and communicating ideas. Observational drawing helps children learn about the world, improves their observational skills, develops creative thinking, and builds confidence. Once we can draw from observation, we need no tricks, no guidebooks, no formulas, and no stereotypes. This 6-week course will involve learning to "see" and draw essential visual elements such as line, shape, form, value, space, and texture, and studying ways to organize them. Through gradual building up of drawing skills, students will be guided to a final project at the end of the course.

By pressing deep textures into paper, you will create subtle and dynamic prints which change with the angle of light and the position of the viewer. You will learn how to carve your design into a traditional lino block and how to print / emboss using a printing press. Other ways of embossing, involving assorted items and textured paper, will also be explored. Discover a world of texture and shadow that can lead you along exciting new printmaking paths. POTTERY WHEEL FOR BEGINNERS

Instructor: Various | Skill Level: Beginner

These 6-week and 8-week courses are for those with little to no clay experience who want to learn the proper techniques for creating wheel thrown pottery. Lessons will cover wedging, centering, throwing, trimming, and finishing. Focus is on learning to center the clay and making basic cylinders and bowls - the foundation for creating mugs, vases, and other forms. Students will also be introduced to glazing and learn basic techniques to get started in the studio. The eight-week course offers an additional glazing and wheel class to the 6-week course.

Completing these beginner-level courses will qualify members to use the clay studio on a dropin basis. Drop-in sessions allow students the time and space to refine their skills and work on their own projects.

Price includes one bag of clay and a personal clay tool kit. Additional clay is available for purchase at the VCAC front desk.

Note: Students should bring an apron, clear plastic recycling bag and an old towel. Please leave rings, watches, and bracelets at home. Long hair should be tied back. Long nails are not recommended.

Students will bring ready-to-fire bisque-ware and learn to apply glaze, fire pieces safely, and clean and protect their work. Students should bring 3-6 pieces of WSO Clay bisque-ware, no larger than 6"x 6" (a variety of sizes is advised). Size restrictions ensure there is room in the kiln to fire everyone's work and WSO clay produces the best results. Firing will be done outdoors and is very smoky. Please dress accordingly and ensure you have closed toed shoes. A 30-minute lunch break will be provided.

GLASS - FOR ADULTS

INTRODUCTION TO STAINED GLASS

Instructor: Terry Dunstan | Skill Level: All

Fun & easy to learn! This 2-part class is designed to introduce students to the art of stained glass, using the copper foil method of construction.
